Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be Graduating High School senior with an acceptance for a Montana College, University or Trade School.
2. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. Completed application along with a typed 500 word or less essay, about what being a credit union member means to you, what degree you are pursuing, and how you will utilize your degree to enhance your community.
4. Two references with signed letters of recommendation.
5. Copy of official High School Transcript

Award Criteria:

2. Community Involvement
3. Extra-Curricular Activities
4. References/Recommendations

3. The scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's school in the spring, after enrollment is verified.
